

Rules for Story Slam

1. Story length must be 8 minutes or less and true “as you remember it.”
2. The theme for June 19 is “Hot Time in the Old Town Tonight.” It is up to your interpretation of this theme as to what kind of story you tell.
3. There will be 5 judges who will award up to 10 points each. The highest and lowest scores will be thrown out and the middle three scores will be averaged for a final score.
4. There will be a ½ point penalty for each 15 seconds you go over the time limit.
5. A time keeper will begin your time when your story begins. A two minute, one minute, and time warning will be given by a visual cue.
6. Your story needs to be appropriate for children and adults. No use of profanity.
7. When you arrive at the event, you must sign in and place your name in the hat to tell.
8. Tellers will be drawn in random order by the emcee.
9. After tellers have completed the program, prizes will be awarded as follows:
1st prize-\$50, 2nd prize-\$25, 3rd prize-\$15, Most unique use of theme-\$10
All prize winners will automatically be entered in the Grand Story Slam to be held in 2019.
10. Must be 12 or older to participate.
11. Participants are not allowed to use props unless they can be carried on the tellers person.
