JUNE- 4 DAY CAMPS

JUNE 9-13 (M-TH)

"Face Off Camp" with Lisa Slaker, Grades 3rd-6th, 9 AM-12 Noon:

Everyone has a face and in this camp we will turn your face and others into works of art. From collages, to cartoons, to caricature, to playing cards, and more, come learn many techniques in the art of creating portraits using a variety of mediums and more. So much fun....you will see yourself in a whole new way! **COST: \$100 and minimum of 6 students required for the camp to make**

JUNE 16-19 (M-TH)

"Under The Sea" with Eryn DeMoss, Grades PreK4/K5, 10-11 AM:

So many things live under the sea and with Ms. Eryn it will be a hands on art project for every moment as you learn new ways to create living creatures from under the sea as well as get your hands into growing things that also live under the sea. Come explore with us! **COST: \$65 and a minimum of 6 students required for camp to make.**

"OddBallZ Art" with Ann Cotton, Grades 1st/2nd, 10-11 AM:

Ms. Ann has really pulled some odd ball art projects out of her backpack to make this camp all the more fun. From fruit painting to thread a bead windchimes to flowers on a stick and paper mache, we have so many projects we need to get done each day that you will never be bored! **COST: \$65 and a minimum of 6 students required for camp to make.**

JUNE 23-26 (M-TH)

“Clothing and Canvas” with Ann Cotton, grades 4th-6th, 10 AM-12 Noon:

this class can bring a whole new look to come of your favorite clothing like jeans and t-shirts and tennis shoes! Everything you work on is yours already. **STUDENTS WILL NEED TO BRING** a clean, washed 100% white cotton t-shirt, a pair of washed white tennis shoes, and your favorite old pair of jeans-washed and ready to go to the class. We will be t-shirt painting, doodling shoes, appliqueing jeans, making a multifiber scarf, and fabric decoupage on canvas. So much to, but then none of your clothes will look like anyone else's!!! **COST: \$100 and a minimum of 6 students required for camp to make.**

JUNE CLASSES

These classes meet once a week on the days listed

MONDAYS, JUNE 9, 16, 23, 30

“Clay Class” with Olga McBride, grades 3rd-6th, 10 AM-12 Noon.

Put your hand into the cool feeling of clay, and create. Ms. Olga will introduce you to all kinds of clay from modeling clay, to air dry clay, to bisque clay and more. Create some masterpieces for your room or to share with friends. **NOTE: pottery classes will require at least 3 visits to create, fire, glaze, fire and pick up your piece so be prepared to come at least 3 times so choose which 3 days you want to attend and pay for those. COST: \$40 for 4 classes, minimum of 6 students to register for this class to make**
